Qualifications

- 1 All students must be currently enrolled at a college or university level institution.
- 2 English proficiency for non-native speakers.
(TOEFL is not required, however, your English should be proficient enough to take courses conducted in English).

Application Materials

- 1 Completed application form (<http://oia.cau.ac.kr>)
- 2 Official transcript from your university
- 3 Official letter of recommendation
- 4 One passport-size photo
- 5 Copy of passport
- 6 TB test (Tuberculosis test) results - Digital Copy to cauwinter@cau.ac.kr :
Students should provide results (in English). The result should be issued after October 18, 2017.

Application Procedures

- 1 Fill out and submit the online application form (<http://oia.cau.ac.kr>) by December 10, 2017.
- 2 Receive confirmation email with invoice.
- 3 Pay admission fee, tuition and additional fees in full by December 15, 2017.
(The admission fee is waived for partner university students).
- 4 Receive a Letter of Admission.
